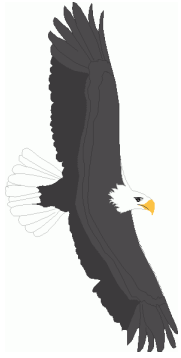


## V & O Assemblies
